Dear Friends,



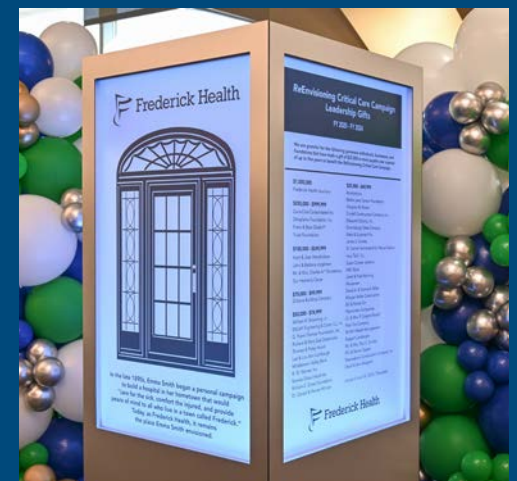

On June 30, 2024, we officially closed our ReEnvisioning Critical Care Campaign—and surpassed our fundraising goal!



Together, we raised
\$14,849,992.60!



In 2019 we embarked on our five-year ReEnvisioning Critical Care Campaign, which supported a \$46 million renovation and expansion project focused on the hospital's Pediatric and Adult Emergency Departments, Intensive Care Unit (ICU), and Cardiac Catheterization Lab.

We're thrilled to share that we surpassed our fundraising goal of \$14.75 million by raising a total of \$14,849,992.60! This transformative achievement is a testament to unwavering dedication and significant collaborative efforts across the entire health system and our community. Patient Impact

We relocated our **Pediatric Emergency and Inpatient Services** from the 2nd Floor to the 1st Floor, which enhanced staffing effectiveness, direct patient access, and improved patient and visitor wayfinding. We also enlarged inpatient rooms (pictured, A), and added a distinct waiting area, family and private bathrooms, a dedicated family zone, and a light-filled play area.

Expansion of our **Adult Emergency Department** included an improved entrance with enhanced security, additional bathroom facilities, and direct access to the hospital's Main Entrance lobby. We also enhanced our patient triage area (pictured, B), and increased to 70 total treatment spaces, including forensics, with the addition of zones for rapid assessment of patients, and increased capacity from five to nine beds for pediatric and adult patients in need of mental health care.

We expanded our **Intensive Care Unit (ICU)** capacity from 18 to 20 beds with enhanced capabilities, larger patient rooms, private bathrooms, dedicated family zones, and an enhanced waiting area (pictured, C) and provider consultation spaces to increase privacy.

We expanded from two to three **Cardiac Catheterization Labs** with advanced technology, increased from six to 16 private pre/post procedure bays (pictured, D) to increase service capacity and allow more direct vertical access from the Emergency Department for life-saving procedures.



Pediatric Emergency Department

"I love the new Pediatric ED waiting and triage area! So smart to make a separate space separated from the adults. We felt very safe behind a security kiosk as well."

"Best experience I ever had at a hospital ED. Seen right away...excellent care. My grandson now WANTS to go to the hospital!"

"The waiting and triage area is very child friendly with the murals and cartoons playing on the TV. Both me and my son were comforted. And we didn't have to wait long at all which was great!"

Adult Emergency Department

I was triaged quickly and moved to a room—with a door rather than just a curtain—this was important because it was a Saturday night and the ED was very busy. Tests were ordered and happened within a couple of hours. My issue was accurately identified and I was discharged with the necessary medications."

"I had not been home to Frederick since joining the Navy in 1995. I've been all over the US and abroad and I've very pleased with the service we received. It made me proud to return home and experience the high quality of professionalism at Frederick Health."

"I arrived just in time to be cared for by four angels during my first-ever seizure. I experienced help with a smile and a soft touch. I am not a patient without challenges. My utmost gratitude for having an expertly staffed ED available when I needed it."

Intensive Care Unit (ICU)

"We are thankful to have such a fine hospital right here in our backyard. We have always supported Frederick Health financially, but it takes on a different meaning when it gets to be a life-threatening personal need. We won't be complaining anymore about the construction inconveniences!"

"My first overnight stay in a hospital ever was in your ICU. It is a beautiful new space. My family was comfortable visiting me and I loved being able to have them there with me."

"From someone who has been in the ICU several times, all I can say is 'what an improvement'. Even the staff seem happier in the new space."

Cardiac Catheterization Lab

A Lifetime of Generosity

How many can claim the unique legacy of having their children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren all born in the same hospital where they themselves were born?

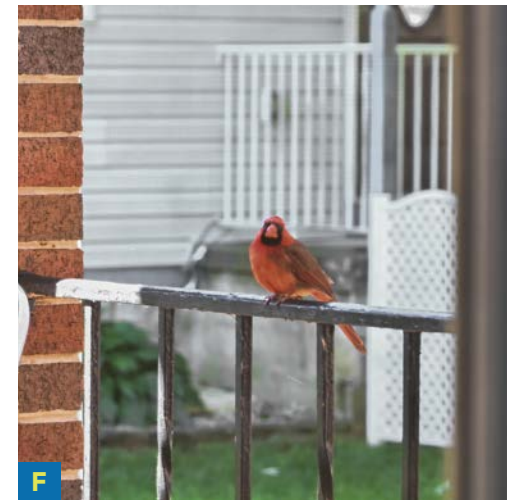
Kathryn Nicodemus can.



Kathryn Nicodemus will tell you that she and her late husband, Charlie, have had a lifelong relationship with Frederick Health. Charlie was born in 1929 and Kathryn was born in 1932 at what was then known as Frederick City Hospital. Years later, both of their children, John and Kitty, were born at what was then called Frederick Memorial Hospital. The hospital also welcomed the births of Kathryn and Charlie's grandchildren and great-grandchildren in the years that followed. Kathryn and Charlie were married for 70 years before Charlie's passing in 2022.

The Nicodemus family has been closely involved with Frederick Health in various ways over the years. Kitty was a youth volunteer (what was then known as a Candy Stripper) in the Intensive Care Unit for eight years. John's wife, Ellen, a longtime nurse in the Pediatrics Department, was named Frederick Health's 2024 Nurse of the Year by her peers—the hospital's ultimate nursing honor.

"It is an institution worthy of support," says Kathryn, recalling the conversation that led to the couple's initial gift. "We met with the hospital's leadership in 1991 and were so impressed with all the new healthcare services that were being brought to the community that we decided to join the Order of the Good Samaritan with a gift of \$10,000." In the 32 years that followed, she and Charlie made generous gifts to each of the hospital's capital campaigns.



This year, Kathryn made a transformative leadership gift to the ReEnvisioning Critical Care Campaign, bringing their lifetime giving total to more than \$425,000.

The tradition of giving in the Nicodemus family extends to the next generation. This past year, John and Ellen joined the Order of the Good Samaritan, also in support of the ReEnvisioning Critical Care Campaign. “In terms of decisions about giving, the hospital was at the top of our list,” says John. Their gift was made in honor of his parents, and as a tribute to Ellen who retired this year after 19 years of service. The following quote by Jim Elliot, John adds, perfectly encapsulates his family’s thoughts on charitable giving: “He is no fool who gives what he cannot keep to gain that which he cannot lose.”

Kathryn and Charlie’s generosity has touched countless lives in Frederick. In addition to Frederick Health, Kathryn and Charlie have made substantial contributions to The Community Foundation of Frederick County, Rotary Club of Frederick, Hood College, and the Methodist Church of Walkersville. In 1998, Kathryn and Charlie were recognized for their commitment to the Frederick community when they were named Frederick Health’s Good Samaritans of the Year. This is an honor that means a lot to the Nicodemus family and the award is still proudly displayed in Kathryn’s home.

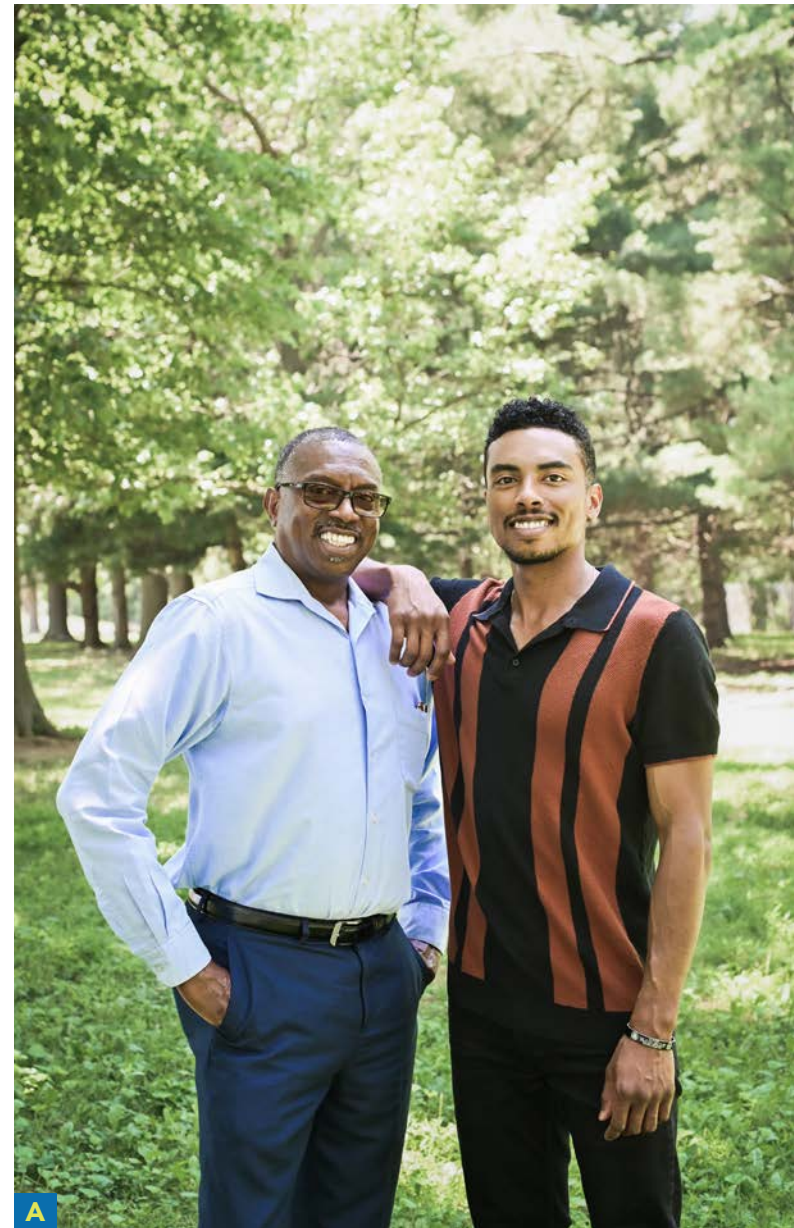
When asked to share her thoughts about Frederick Health and how its services have grown over time, Kathryn says, “I think it is wonderful. Great effort is made to constantly improve the facilities and services and yet it has still retained its original ‘family feel.’ I would greatly encourage supporting the hospital. Generational Giving

"Without good health, none of your dreams can come true," says Daryl Boffman, Sr., who, following his active-duty service in the U.S. Army moved to Frederick and established two successful technology companies. Daryl has always found a way to contribute to the community, whether it was serving on the boards of the Frederick County Chamber of Commerce and Heartly House, the Board of Associates at Hood College, or through his current role as Secretary of the Frederick Health Board of Directors. He and his wife, Maria, joined the Order of the Good Samaritan in 2021 to support the *ReEnvisioning Critical Care Campaign*. "I saw becoming a Good Samaritan as helping the community at its core," he says.

Daryl Boffman, Jr. shares his father's sentiments. In 2024, Daryl Jr. also became a member of the Order of the Good Samaritan. Daryl Jr. is co-founder, CEO, & CIO of Antelux Capital Partners, a local investment company, which he established following his active-duty service as a U.S. Army Special Forces soldier in the war in Afghanistan.

“My dad has always been involved in the community in some way and I admire that about him,” says Daryl Jr. This is an attribute his father instilled in him and his siblings. “Everyone associated with the Order of the Good Samaritan is someone who wants to contribute to the community. I wanted to be a part of that,” he shares.

“The newly renovated and expanded Emergency Department and Intensive Care Unit, part of the *ReEnvisioning Critical Care Project*, are just awesome,” says Daryl Sr. “To complete this project—especially in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic—was amazing! One of the biggest medical challenges in Maryland is getting people through hospital emergency departments.” Frederick Health’s recently reimagined and expanded Emergency Department streamlines the process.

Daryl Jr. can attest to this personally. “A few months ago, my son cut his eye and we were panicked,” he recalls. “We rushed him to the Frederick Health Pediatric Emergency Department where the doctors treated him with such care. They made my son feel so comfortable. And it was so quick. It was an in and out experience.”

“Everyone in our community will at some point need hospital services,” adds Daryl Sr. “How many other local entities can you say that about? I would challenge anyone who wants to ensure the continued enhancement of our local hospital and the services it provides to take action.”

Good Samaritan Education Series: Getting to the Heart of the Matter: Cardiac Care at Frederick Health

Our latest Good Samaritan Education Series, *Getting to the Heart of the Matter: Cardiac Care at Frederick Health*, was held on February 22, 2024 at Frederick Health Village. The event featured an informative and engaging presentation led by Frederick Health Vice President of Surgical & Support Services, Mike McLane, Co-Medical Director of Interventional Cardiology, Dr. Chao-Wei Hwang, and Director of Cardiac and Vascular Services, Kristin Deely. Attendees gained exclusive knowledge on the life-saving, state-of-the-art cardiac services available at Frederick Health, as well as the risk factors of heart disease and steps to take when experiencing symptoms of a cardiac event.

Good Samaritan *of the Year*

First presented in 1991, the Good Samaritan of the Year award recognizes individuals whose lives have demonstrated “actions or achievements that have substantially advanced patient care, the economic health of the hospital, or the physical safety of Frederick Health’s patients and personnel, as well as a selfless commitment to improving the quality of life in the entire Frederick community.”

This year’s recipient was Brooke DeSantis, who was awarded for her advocacy and activism in the prevention of sepsis. Sepsis affects at least 1.7 million Americans each year, claiming an estimated 350,000 lives. Lesser known than many medical conditions, sepsis—the body’s overwhelming and life-threatening response some people experience with a bacterial infection, COVID-19, flu, or a fungal infection—can lead to serious tissue damage, organ failure, and death. Sepsis is the leading cause of death in hospitals nationwide.

Devastated by the sudden loss of their 5-year-old son, Lochlin, to flu-induced sepsis in January 2020, Brooke and William DeSantis vowed to educate and protect as many people as possible from the deadly impact of the influenza virus and sepsis. Within nine months of Lochlin's death, the couple had established a nonprofit organization, Love for Lochlin, organizing outdoor pop-up clinics across Frederick County. There, the Love for Lochlin team educates residents about the lethality of influenza and sepsis and administers free flu shots. If not for the clinics, many attendees would not have access to the education or vaccines.

Brooke quickly expanded the scope of these pop-up clinics in 2021–2022 through alliances with Frederick Health, Frederick County Health Department, the national Sepsis Alliance, as well as the nursing school programs at Hood College, Frederick Community College, and Mount St. Mary's University. In addition to flu shots, clinic attendees receive free COVID testing, immunizations, masks and hand sanitizers, food, clothing giveaways, and more—all supported by local nonprofit organizations, businesses, and the generosity of private citizens and foundations. Today, the alliances continue to expand, providing additional services to clinic attendees.

Love for Lochlin organized 43 clinics in its first year, administering 644 immunizations. Since the nonprofit's founding, more than 360 such clinics have been organized, providing nearly

5,150 vaccinations. Love for Lochlin is an entirely volunteer, unsalaried effort.

Already reaching thousands of Frederick County residents, Brooke wanted to do more. She wanted to ensure that standardized diagnostic and treatment protocols for sepsis were instituted in all Maryland hospitals and urgent care centers. In the State of Maryland, some 85 adults and 20 children are diagnosed with sepsis each day. Through Brooke's relentless efforts, when Lochlin's Law is enacted in January 2025, hospitals and urgent care centers across the State will be required to implement evidence-based protocols for the early recognition and treatment of sepsis and septic shock. Her work to expand Lochlin's Law nationwide has already begun.

Brooke has turned a personal tragedy into opportunity. The mission of Love for Lochlin is to educate and protect as many people as possible from the deadly impacts of the influenza virus. "No one should have to go through the pain and suffering of losing a loved one from a vaccinable disease," said Brooke.

WHY We Give

When Ira and Harriet Click made Frederick their home over 30 years ago, they knew it was important to give back to their local hospital. "I was also impressed by the nursing assistants and health technicians—the ones you see all the time," she adds. "When I needed to be moved from the operating suites to another floor after the procedure, the personnel were equally remarkable there."

"That kind of care and compassion among the employees starts at the top of the organization and trickles down," says Ira. "The hospital was so supportive of Harriet during her stay. She later went to the Emergency Department three times and during each visit the staff always took great care of her. They were always very busy but were so attentive to everyone and had a great attitude."

More recently, Ira was the patient. "I am thankful that Dr. Lamptey-Mills was part of my care team," he says. "He took time to talk with us—he even drew pictures so we would understand what was going to happen during the procedure." Ira's outcome was positive and he is pleased to report that he has had no issues since the surgery.

"We are so grateful to Frederick Health," Ira adds. "We have encouraged our friends to become 1902 Club members. The hospital is such an integral part of our community and we all need to support it."

Melissa herself knows about the unexpected. In 2015 she lost her 7-year old son, Hayden, to histiocytosis, a rare immune system disorder. In response, she set up the nonprofit organization Hayden’s Heroes to promote awareness for the disease.

“You never know when you are going to need help,” she says. “It doesn’t matter if you are financially set, or think you are emotionally strong. At some point you will need help and it feels good to get it from the people you work with—and just as good to be among the donors who provide it.”

Lasting Legacy

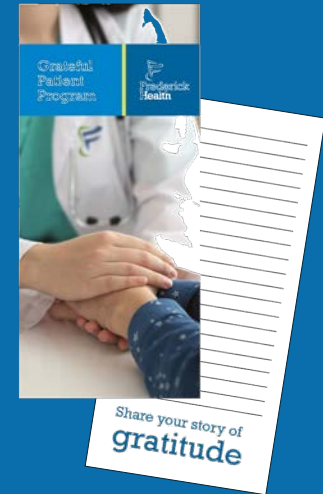

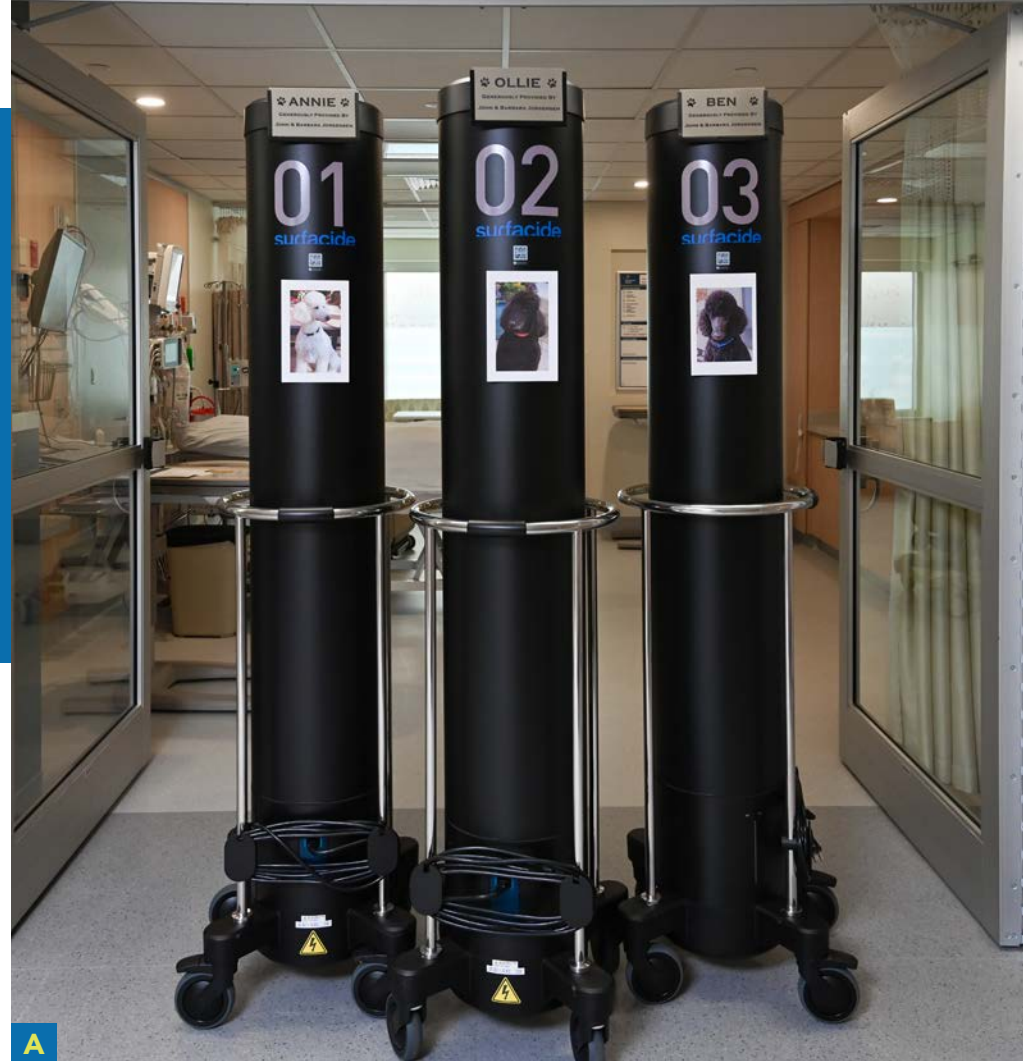

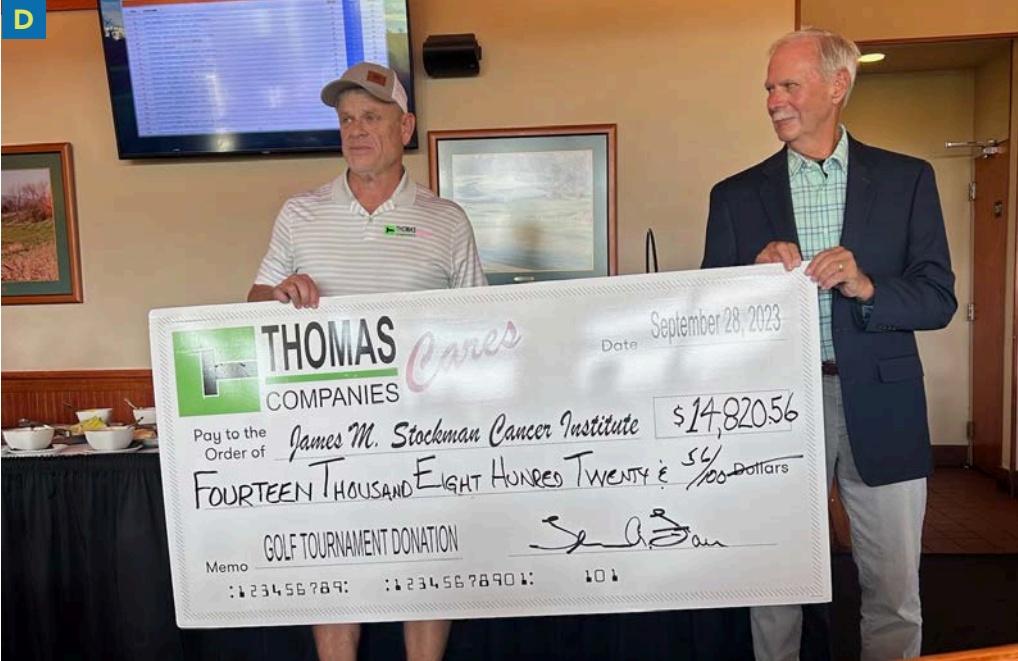
